AFTER-SCHOOL MUSIC TUTORING PROGRAM STUDENT SIGN-UP/PERMISSION FORM

What: An opportunity for 4th and 5th graders at our partner schools to receive free, weekly instrumental music lessons with a high school, college or community musician as part of our after-school music program. Students work one-on-one with volunteers and in ensembles as they learn to read music and play an instrument.

When: After-school until 4:45.

- Leschi Elementary on Tuesdays
- Bailey Gatzert Elementary on Thursdays

How: Complete the attached forms and turn it into your child's teacher by Tuesday, September 29. Complete all of the application pages (signature required several times). Please keep this page at home for future reference.

Transportation: You will need to make transportation arrangements for your student---pick up from school, walk home, attend after-school care, etc. If you indicate that your student needs bus transportation home, we will try to arrange rides on a school bus, which leaves school at approximately 4:45 pm.

Attendance: It is important that your child attend every session, all school year, to receive the maximum benefit from this program. You can help your student attend every session by scheduling other appointments on the days when SMP does not meet.

Choosing an Instrument: Please choose from the following instruments: flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, French horn, violin, viola, cello, bass, piano, acoustic guitar and percussion. **If your student is taking lessons during school, he or she should sign up for the same instrument.** We will make every effort to honor your student's request, although it is dependent on having enough tutors to teach the particular instrument. It is helpful to list a second choice as well in the space provided.

Space is Limited: We depend on volunteers and instrument donations, so we are not always able to provide space for every child. When we start one-on-one tutoring at the end of October, we may need to place some students on a wait list until we find more volunteers.

Volunteers: As a small non-profit, we rely on volunteers to make our program successful. Please consider ways in which you could contribute to the program, whether it be afternoon supervision, recital help, parent communication or other areas.
